'Inherited' - an installation produced as part of glass artist Charlotte Wilkinson's 'Blood Series', a statement piece made up of 45 open vessels, individually attached to the showroom wall for urban living interiors - London Design Festival Open Studio Event – YOUNG FRESH AND BRITISH



The vessels, in varying shades of red and orange, are inspired by 3d microscopic images of Charlotte's own blood cells. Each vessel is individually blown then hung to allow the glass to dictate the final form.

Installed at **urban living interiors** as part of **Young, Fresh and British** 'Inherited' can be designed around any existing furniture/features within the installation space but it can also be a standalone piece of art.

'Each set up is different, I do not preplan the layout, I respond to the space I am given on the day' says Charlotte.

Charlotte Wilkinson is one of the emerging young British designers whose work will be showcased in **Young, Fresh & British**, an Open Studio event curated by Mark Riese, creative director at **urban living interiors**, to be held at their design studio and showroom in Fitzrovia throughout the **London Design Festival**.
